



Code of Conduct for Parents (2017)

- Parents are not allowed on poolside at any time during training sessions and should not engage the coach in conversation from the spectator area whilst they are teaching.
- All parents of children under the age of 11 must remain within the building at all times when your child attends for their session.
- Encourage your child to learn the rules and ensure that they abide by them.
- Discourage unfair practices and arguing with officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport and do not offer incentives for participation, however positive support is encouraged.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes but provide positive feedback to encourage future participation.
- Publicly accept officials' judgments.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
