



# CHESTER LE STREET ASC BONUS BALL SCHEME

## Rules of Participation

- ✓ The bonus ball competition will be a regular fundraiser for Chester le Street ASC.
- ✓ The Bonus Ball co-ordinator acting on behalf of Chester le Street ASC is Fiona Heppell.
- ✓ 59 balls are available for sale at £1 per week.
- ✓ There is no restriction on the number of balls an individual player may select.
- ✓ Balls can be sold to any member 16 years or over

### PRIZE MONEY:

- ✓ Half of the weekly scheme funds will be offered as prize money, up to a maximum of £25.00 per week
- ✓ The remaining half will be retained by Chester le Street ASC to be held in a Team Kit fund, earmarked for the provision of Championship Qualifier and League Event kit only.
- ✓ The winning bonus ball number will be taken from each Saturday's National Lottery Draw commencing on Saturday 7 November 2015.
- ✓ The holder of the number drawn will win the prize for that week.
- ✓ If the winning ball has not been bought, then half of the prize money will be retained by Chester le Street ASC and the other half will be rolled over to the next draw.
- ✓ The winner will receive their prize within one week, and all results will be displayed on the Club Noticeboard, Club Website and Club Facebook page.

### Additional Rules

1. The Bonus Ball shall run all year round, a minimum of 25 balls must be sold to enable the scheme to run.
2. One person shall be allocated to each number and each number costs £1 per week – multiple ball allocation is permitted.
3. Payment shall be made in £5 increments, payable in advance commencing Friday 6 November 2015 and every 5th week thereafter. Prepayments for future periods will be accepted.
4. The winning ball shall be that of the bonus ball that is drawn in the National Lottery Saturday night draw.
5. For a ball to be eligible to win a prize, payment must have been received in advance no later than the Friday preceding the current week's draw

6. If a person's ball is drawn and money has not been paid for, then he/she will not be eligible to collect the winnings and a rollover will incur ( see above)
7. Continued non-payment for a ball will result in the ball being re-sold at the start of the next quarterly period.
8. If more than 59 people want to join the scheme a waiting list will operate.
9. Balls are allocated on a first come first served basis.
10. The co-ordinator reserves the right to refuse payout if one or more of the rules above are not complied with and their word is final.
11. The bonus ball co-ordinator is not paid and may enter the competition if they wish.
